## SUMMARY OF UPDATES:

- 1) Reference to Borderline Intellectual Functioning is now included, as well as changes to the Mental Handicap verification section. This language is now consistent with the changes made to the Eligibility Chapter - reference [VRIS Update of 4-23-10](#).
- 2) The section on “eligibility considerations” has been amended in consideration of the potential need for additional documentation of an impairment. The additional information may be necessary for students applying to the Employment Program when there is a medical or mental health condition that requires a diagnosis from a medical professional or clinical psychologist.
- 3) All reference to the application and IPE parent notification letters has been removed. It is no longer necessary to send notification letters to parents/guardians when the student makes application to the Employment Program, or when the IPE is completed. NOTE: If the Consent form on file is version prior to 06-08, the parent/guardian must sign the application and the IPE if the student is under the age of 19.
